

Rental Policy – we look forward to working with you!

- **Availability** The camp facility is available throughout the year with the exception of previously scheduled events. The purpose of this campground is to glorify God and we would like your event to do the same. The camp board of directors has the right to refuse or accept all applications.
- Application The application below must be completely filled out by the event coordinator and sent to the above address. A non-refundable reservation deposit of \$50 is required and half of the estimated fee needs to be paid before your event begins. The remaining fee should be paid before leaving. The \$50 reservation deposit will count toward your total cost.
- Fee Rental fees are \$4 per person per day. Any part of a calendar day counts, so an overnight stay would be 2 days. You will be charged for a minimum of 30 people. In all cases, you must remit at least half of the fee before your event begins.

Our summer season stretches from May 1 to September 30. If your event is outside of that season, an extra fee of **\$30** per building will be charged for each building used with running water. Our paintball course and equipment are available upon request at an additional cost.

- **Cleaning/Damage** All event coordinators must see that the campus is clean before leaving. You are responsible for physical damage to camp facilities. All equipment must be returned to its location and all trash cans emptied in the dumpster. Cleaning or repair costs incurred by the camp will be billed to the event coordinators. Feel free to discuss any concerns regarding this matter with the camp director.
- **Insurance** All groups are responsible for their own liability and accident insurance.
- **Phone** Local calls only from camp phones. Cell service is not the best but we can direct you to areas of better service within the campground.
- **Food** Your group must supply all of your own food unless other arrangements have been made with the camp. Refrigerator and freezer space will be made available to you. Toilet paper and paper towels will be provided in the dorms, but you must provide all other consumable supplies.

If you would like us to cater your event please contact the director for menus and cost.

- **Bedding** You must bring all of your own bedding and toiletries.
- **Staff** Your group is responsible to staff all aspects of your own program. Additional staff can be provided on a limited basis if advance notice is given.

Homeward Trail Bible Camp Rules for Rentals

This camp has been dedicated to God. We gladly make our facility available to other groups who seek to honor the Lord Jesus. The following rules adopted by the board of directors seek to protect the physical facility and the camp's reputation.

- 1. Recreation equipment is there for your use but please return all equipment to its proper location. If you wish to use the paintball equipment you need to contact the director.
- 2. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, firearms, and other weapons are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Modest clothing should be worn at all times.
- 4. Please help us lower costs by turning lights, heat, and air conditioning off when not in use.
- 5. Please stay out of the creek. Do not trespass on neighboring property. Please ask for a description of the camp boundaries if you are not sure.
- 6. Horses and other livestock are not allowed.
- 7. We would like you to keep all animals outside.

Homeward Trail Bible Camp Statement of Faith

We stand for and emphasize the foundational truths of the historic Christian faith held in common by like-minded evangelical Christians. Our beliefs are stated as follows:

- 1. We believe that there is one God, creator and sustainer of the universe, existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 2. We believe that the Bible is the Word of God, verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit, is inerrant in the original manuscripts and infallible, our only authority for faith and practice.
- 3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His substitutionary death upon the cross, in His bodily resurrection, in His victory over sin and His enemy Satan, In His present exaltation at the Father's right hand, and in His personal imminent return, at any time, in power and great glory.
- 4. We believe in the fall and lost estate of all people, whose total depravity necessitates regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation.
- 5. We believe that salvation consists of the forgiveness of sins, the atonement by the substitutionary death and shed blood of Jesus Christ our Savior, the imputation of Christ's righteousness, and the gift of eternal life, received by grace through faith alone, entirely apart from works.
- 6. We believe in the ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life, and by whom the Church, the Body of Christ, is gifted and equipped to serve and glorify God.
- 7. We believe the Church, or Body or Bride of Christ consists only of those who are born again through faith in Jesus Christ, for whom He now makes intercession in Heaven and for whom He shall come again.
- 8. We believe in the bodily resurrection of all people: those who have trusted in Jesus Christ, the ultimate Judge, will receive everlasting life and blessedness in Heaven, those who have not will be separated from God forever and will receive everlasting punishment in hell.
- 9. We believe in the personality of Satan, called the Devil, that he presently exercises great influence over unsaved people, and that he actively fights against God's program on earth.
- 10. We believe that Jesus Christ has commanded His Church to go into all the world and preach the gospel to all people, and that this mandate should be a primary concern of all Christians.
